


FIGURE 2: GOOD GOVERNANCE – OUTCOME 2






FIGURE 5: HUMAN DEVELOPMENT – OUTCOME 3


















FIGURE 13: **CLIMATE CHANGE – OUTCOME 1** A well-managed & Long-term maintained environment **Outcome** for Tokelau (2020)Tokelau's improved Tokelau improves **Medium-term** responsiveness to her ability to **Outcomes** environmental risks respond to disaster (2018 - 2019)(Including Boarder risks and post control) disaster recovery ТВС Tokelau has capacity **Short-term** & capability to implement their **Outcomes** Disaster (2016 - 2017)Management **Strategy Environmental Risk** Tokelau has a Disaster Management **Outputs** Management strategy strategy in place incorporating border control
