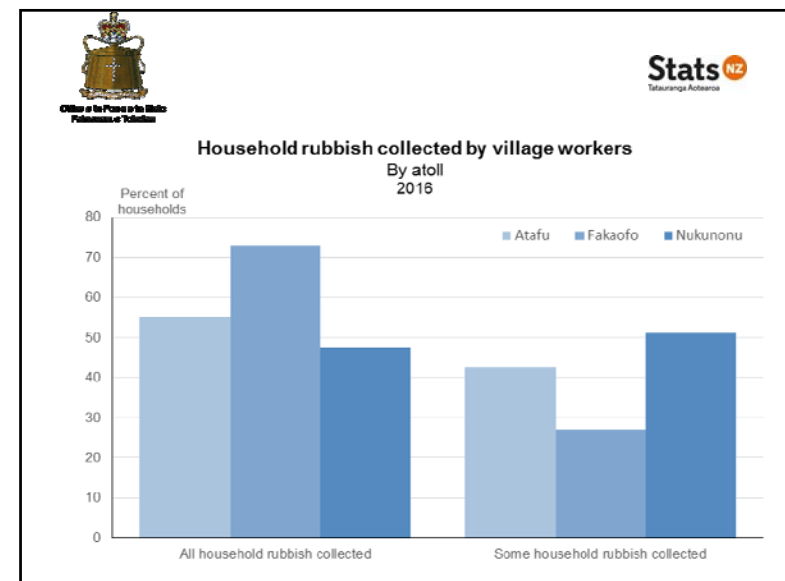
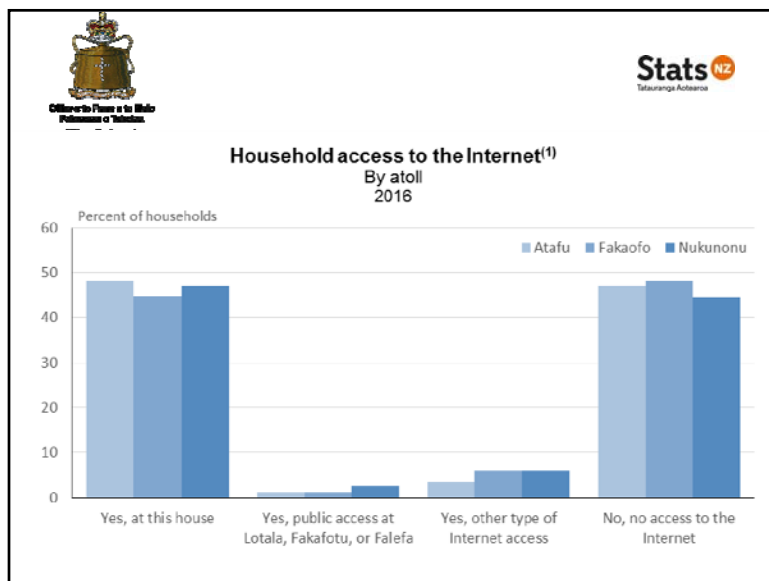
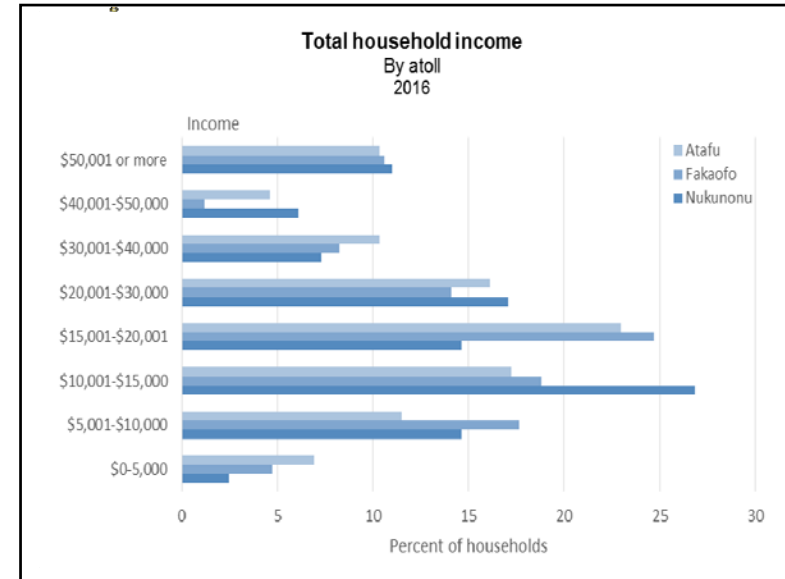
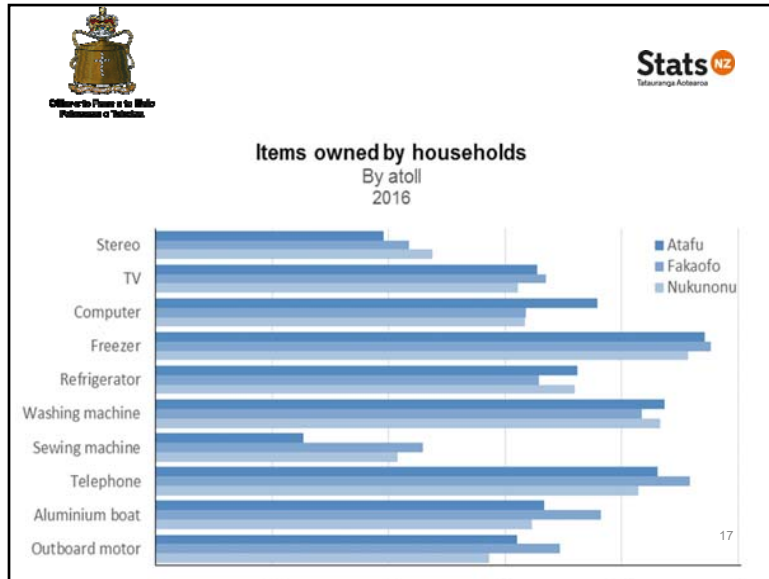
Age-sex distribution Usually resident population present in Tokelau Census night, 2016

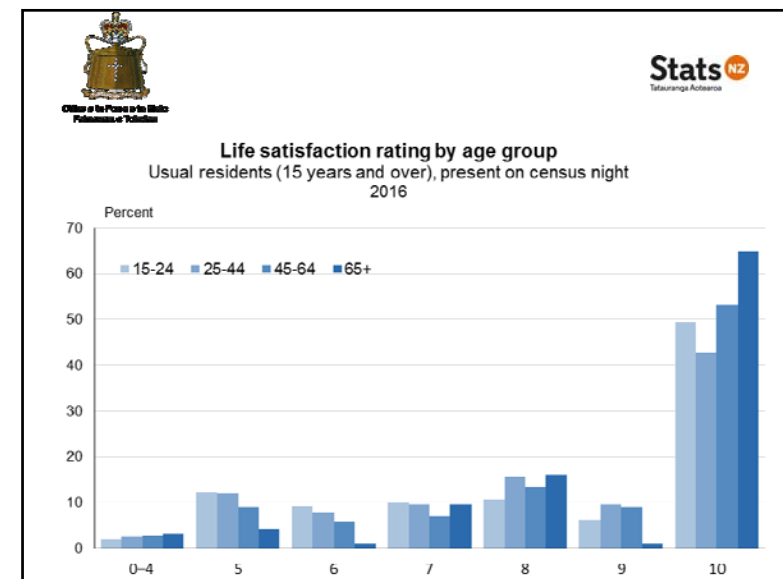
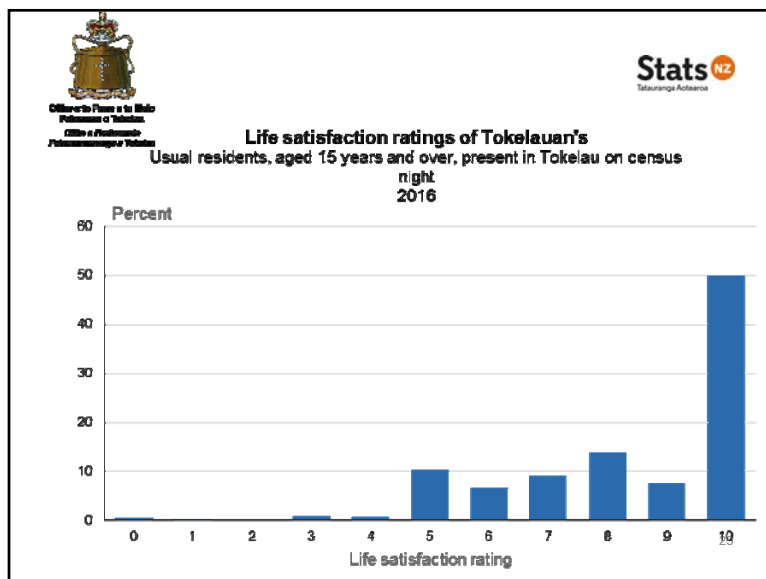
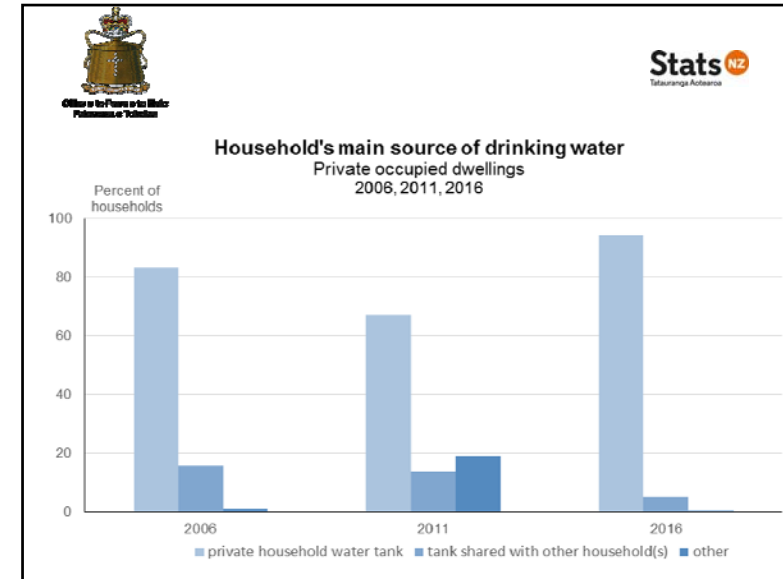
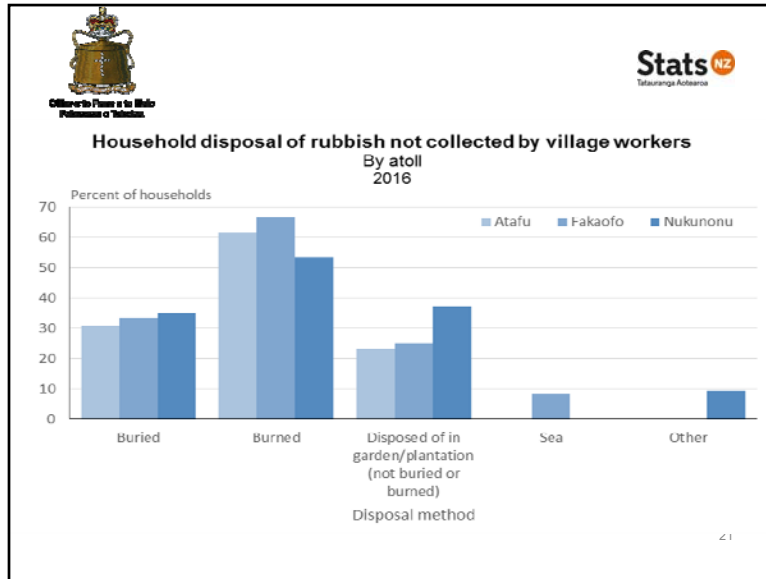


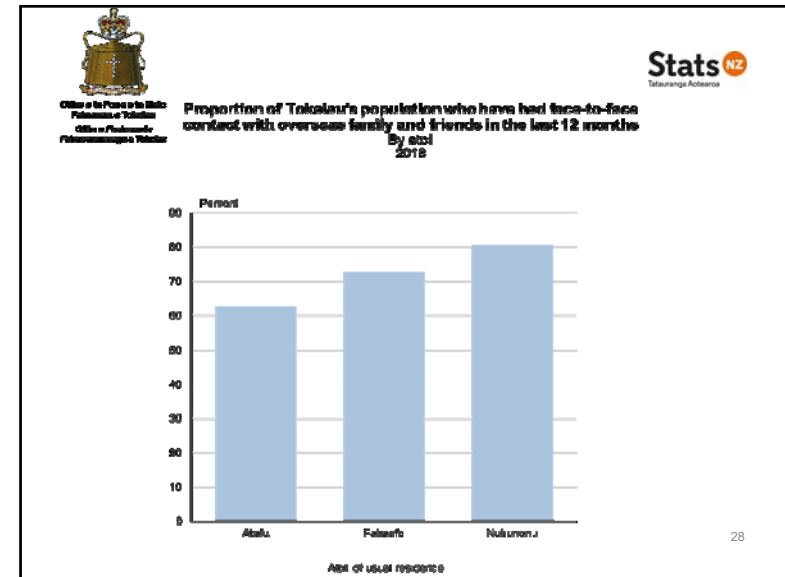
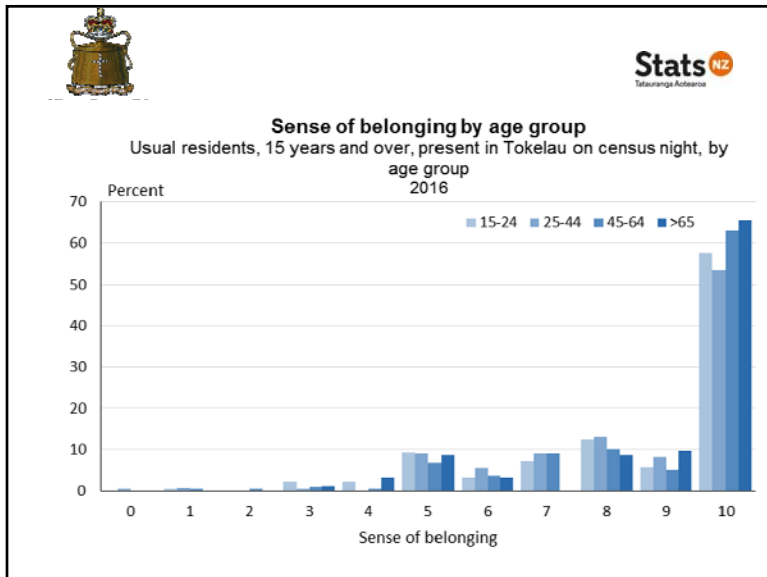
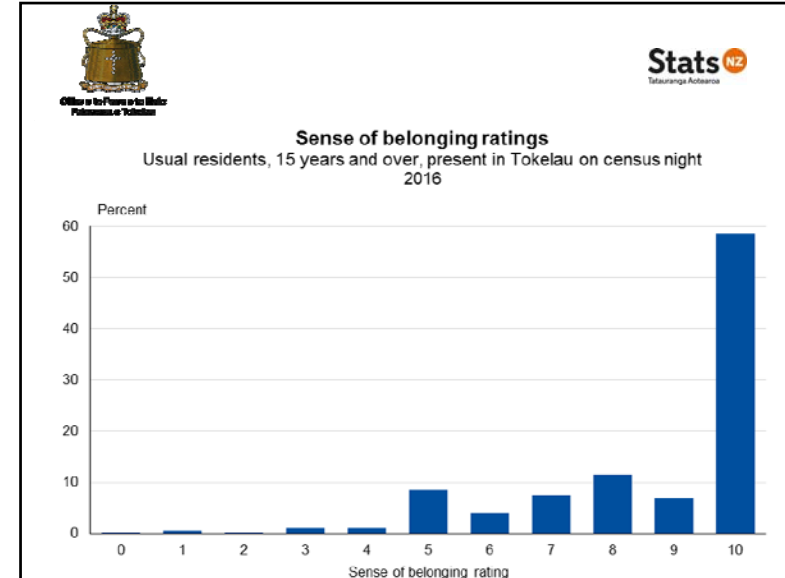
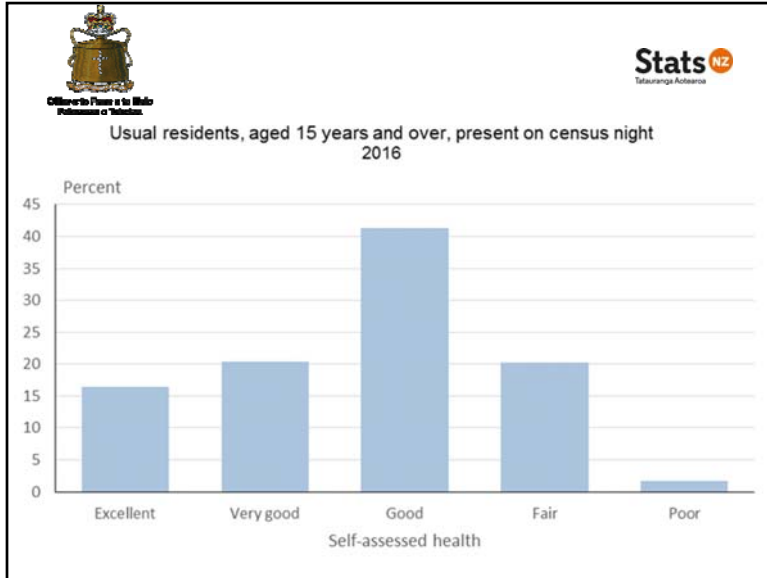


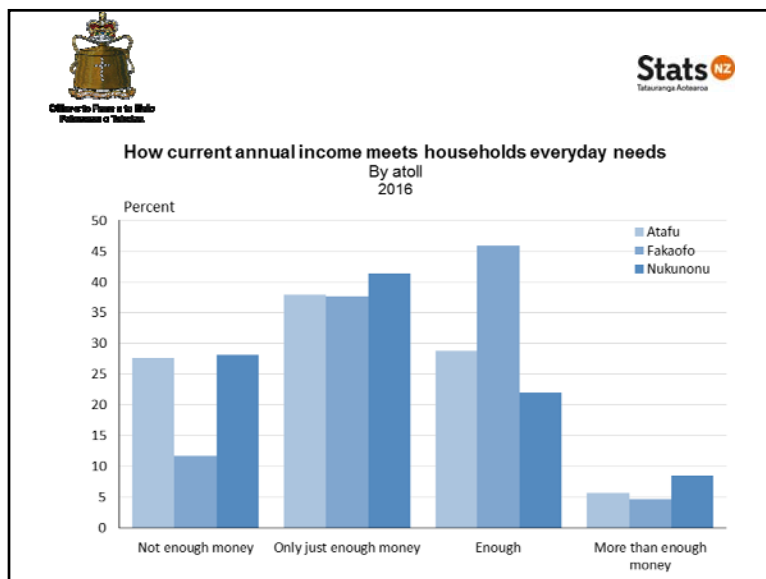
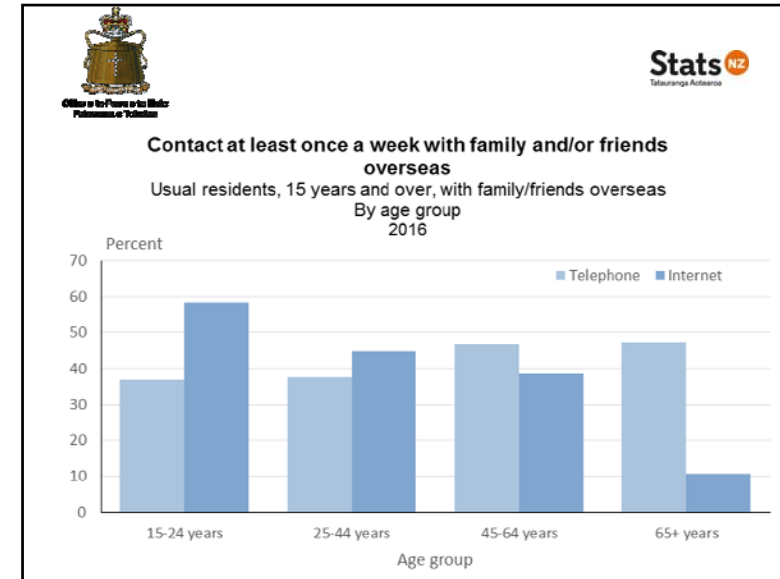
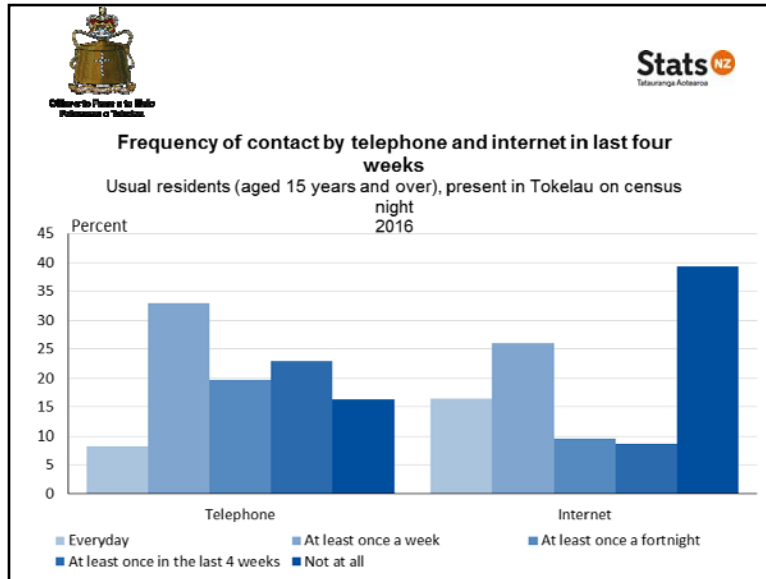

Tokelau Census of Population and Dwellings

The census is the official count of how many people and dwellings there are in Tokelau. Information from the census provides an overall view of the people of Tokelau and the places where they live.

Census information is used to plan vital public services such as education, health, housing, and transport. It is also used to understand how society changes over time.

The census is held once every five years.

2016 Tokelau Census

The 2016 Tokelau Census of Population and Dwellings was held on 18 October 2016. The Office of the Council for the Ongoing Government of Tokelau has again worked with Statistics New Zealand on the Census and analysing the results. All publications are now available on this page.
